



**INVITATION TO BID FOR PROCUREMENT OF GOODS:
 SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF VARIOUS HOSPITAL SUPPLIES
 (RE-BID AND ADDITIONAL ITEMS) FOR F.Y. 2022
 (IB 2022- 01 TO 03)**

- The *National Children's Hospital (NCH)*, using a *single-year* Framework Agreement, through the *2022 General Appropriations Act (GAA) / Income Trust Fund / Revolving Fund of the hospital*, intends to apply the sum of *Seventy-Four Million Two Hundred Fifty-Seven Thousand Six Hundred Two Pesos and Sixty-Five Centavos (Php74,257,602.65)* being the ABC to payments under the contract for each item. Bids received in excess of the total cost per item shall be automatically rejected.

- The *NCH* now invites bids for *Supply and Delivery of Various Hospital Supplies (Re-Bid and Additional Items) for F.Y. 2022*. Delivery of goods is required within fifteen (15) calendar days from issuance of a Call-Off / Purchase Order or any date determined by the PE. Bidders should have completed, within *three (3) years* from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II (Instructions to Bidders).
- Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary "*pass/fail*" criterion as specified in the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184.
 - Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA No. 5183.
- Prospective Bidders may obtain further information from *NCH-BAC Secretariat* and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below during *8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M., Monday to Friday*

The **NCH** will hold a Pre-Bid Conference on **February 17, 2022/Thursday, 9:00A.M.** at **6th Floor Multi-Purpose Hall, Medical Arts Building, NCH** and/or through video conferencing or webcasting **via NCH-BAC official Facebook page—i.e., National Children’s Hospital – Bids and Awards Committee**, which shall be open to prospective bidders.
7. Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat through manual submission at the office address indicated below on or before **March 7, 2022/Monday, 9:00A.M.** at **6th Floor Multi-Purpose Hall, Medical Arts Building, NCH**. Late bids shall not be accepted.
8. All Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in **ITB Clause 14**.
9. Bid opening shall be on **March 7, 2022/Monday, 9:00A.M.** at **6th Floor Multi-Purpose Hall, Medical Arts Building, NCH**. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders’ representatives who choose to attend the activity.

The **NCH** reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Sections 35.6 and 41 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
