

SUBJECT : Fee for On-the-Job Training/ Practicum Applicants

Due to the gradual ease of COVID-19 alert level and return to face-to-face classes per the issuances of the Commission of Higher Education (CHED), we have been receiving applications from higher education institutions (HEI) for on-the-job training (OJT) or practicum of their students under various programs/ courses.

In this regard, a minimal Affiliation Fee amounting to **TWO HUNDRED PESOS ONLY (P200.00)** per student per month (less or equal to one month) shall be settled through our Cashier prior to the start of the training to cover the use of our facilities during the course of their immersion in our institution.

The rate is referenced from the Department of Health's (DOH) Administrative Order No. 54-A s. 2000¹. Moreover, Section 21 of Article IX of the CHED Memorandum Order No. 104 s. 2017² states that the internship fee, which includes administrative costs for OJT/ practicum, is included in the tuition collected from the students.

OJT/ practicum applicants from *state universities and colleges (SUCs) and local universities and colleges (LUCs)* shall be **FREE OF CHARGE**.
